# What is 3 Amigos?

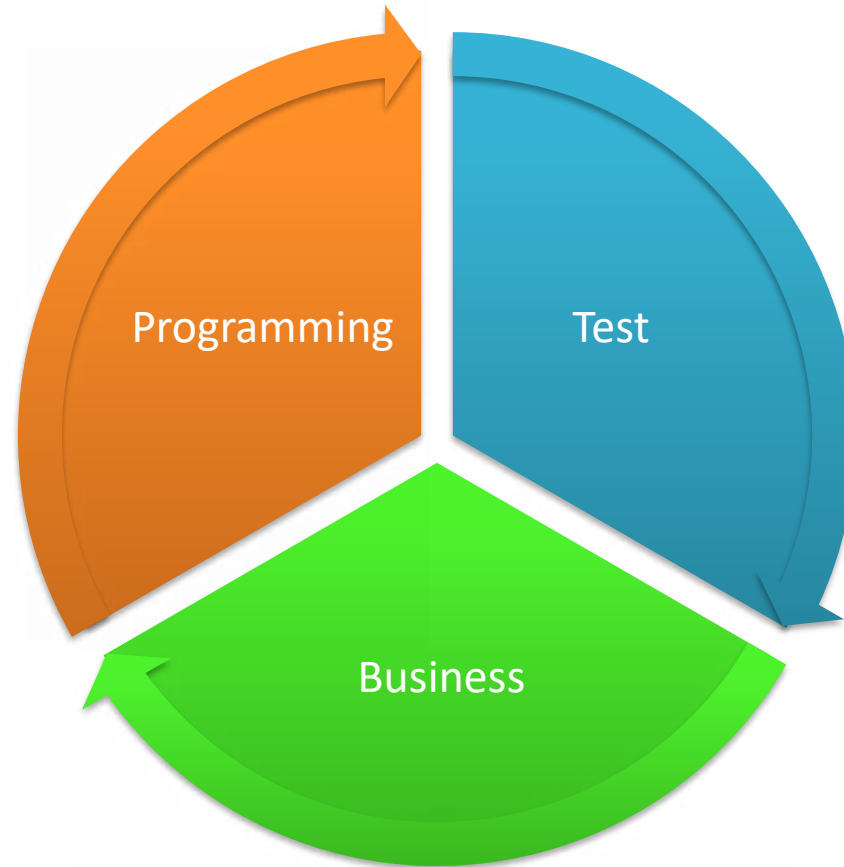
It is a complimentary practice that supports frameworks and methods to understand when an item of work is ready for work to begin or has been completed.

It does not refer to the amount of people involved in the discussion but the three perspectives to be considered when deciding if a work item can be or has been delivered.



# 3 Amigos equals 3 perspectives

- ✓ Given current software development practices can we build a solution?
- ✓ Can we write tests that ensures the code is robust?



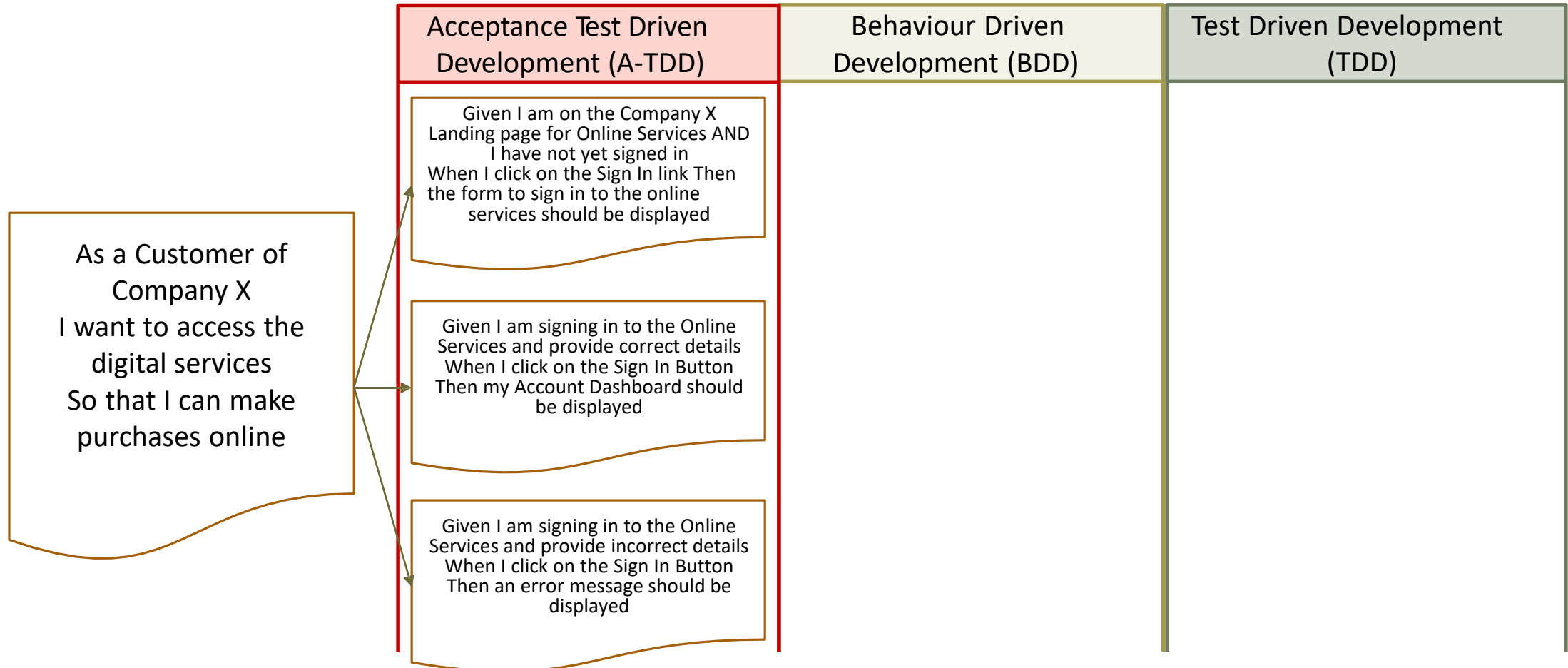
- ✓ Can we test that it works as a feature?
- ✓ Can we test it integrates with the current solution?
- ✓ Can we test that it won't have broken the previous build?

- ✓ Can the business define fit for purpose?
- ✓ Can we test what acceptable means?

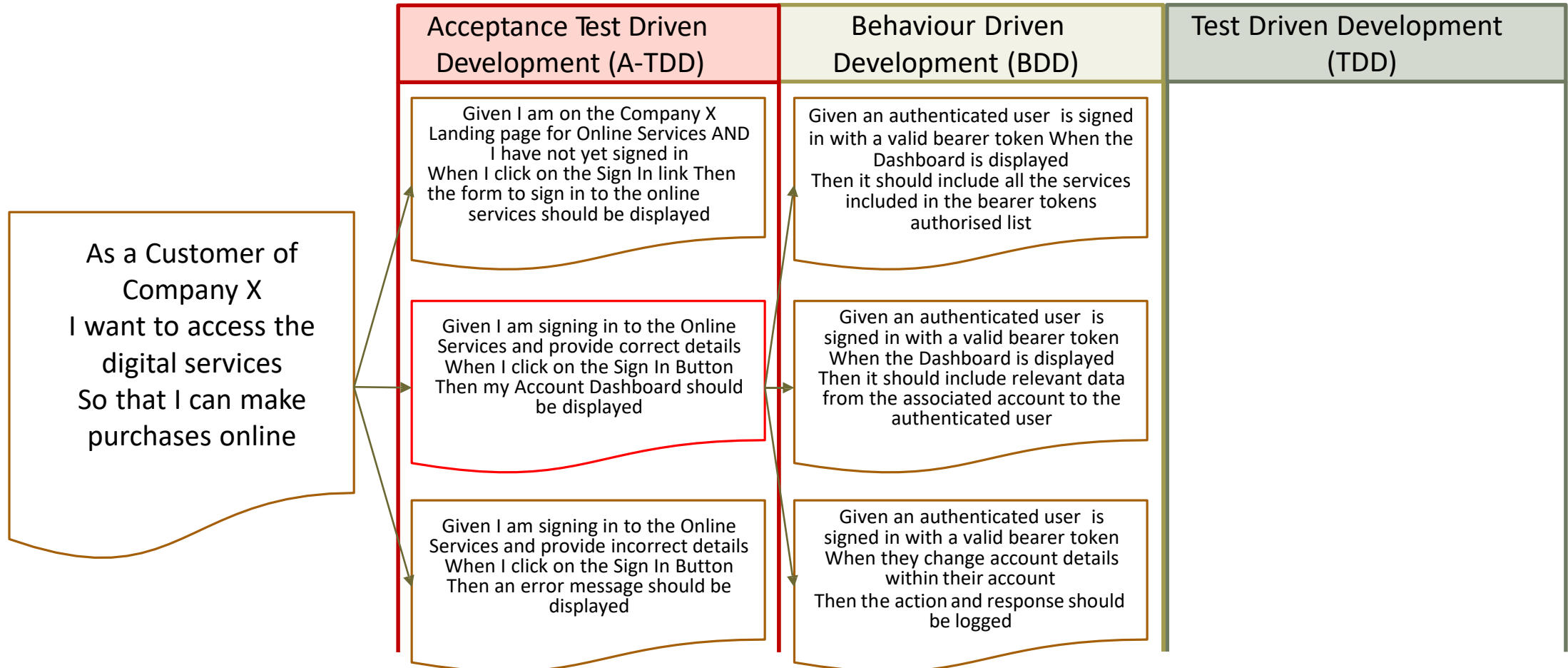

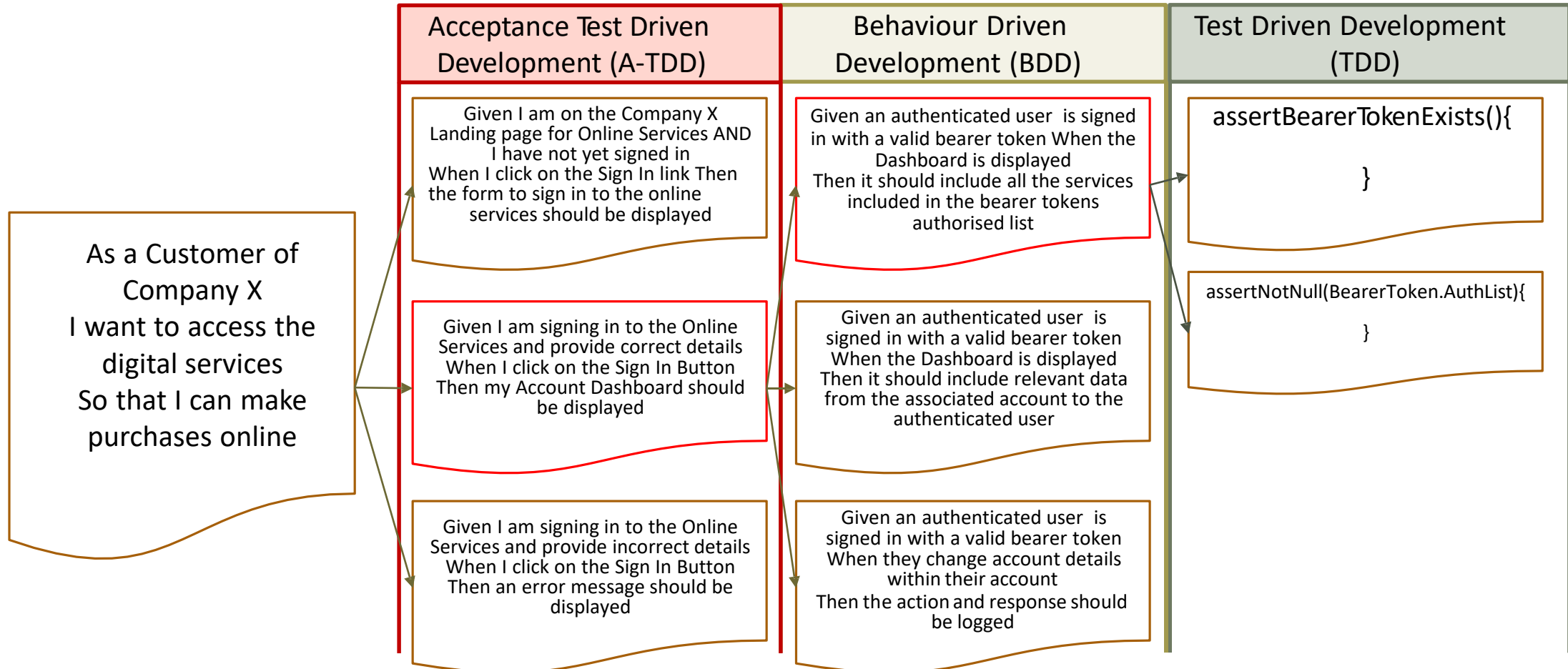
# How the User Story Drives the Acceptance Test



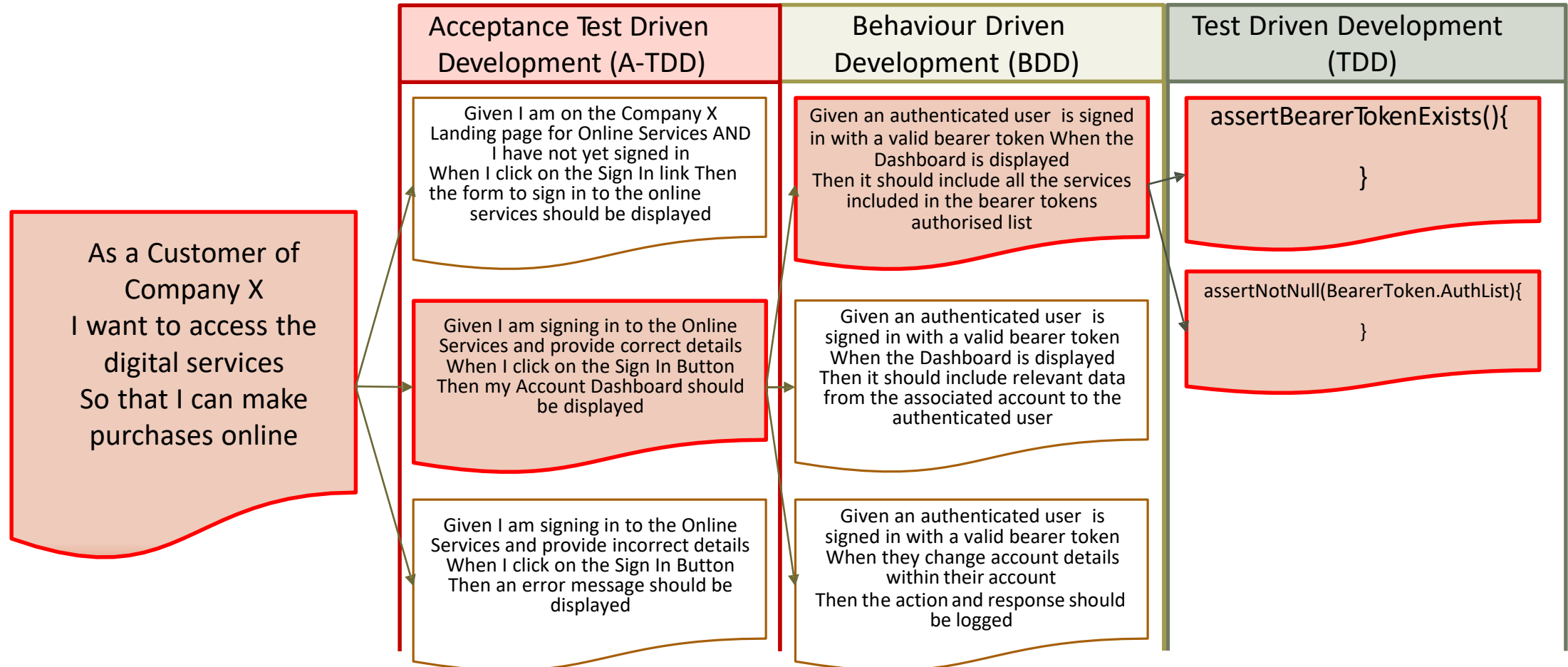
# The Acceptance Tests lead to the System Behaviours
